Homecare agencies employ trained carers and arrange for them to visit you in your home. You may not always have the same carer visiting your home, though the agency will try to match you with someone suitable. How much do they cost? It costs around £ 20 an hour for a carer to come to your home, but this will vary depending on where you live.

For example, the UK inflation rate hovered around 2% at the end of 2018-19, but care home fees increased at more than double that rate (4.7%) in that year. What 's more, in 2018-19 care home fees rose by the biggest annual hike in 10 years.

There are two types of care homes: Care homes without nursing care that provide help with personal care.
