Anatomical Directional Terms. Anterior: In front of, front.

Posterior: After, behind, following, toward the rear. Distal: Away from, farther from the origin. Proximal: Near, closer to the origin.

Dorsal: Near the upper surface, toward the back. Ventral: Toward the bottom, toward the belly. Superior: Above, over.

Anatomical Directional Terms and Body Planes

Anatomical terms of movement are used to describe the actions of muscles upon the skeleton. Muscles contract to produce movement at joints, and the subsequent movements can be precisely described using this terminology. The terms used assume that the body begins in the anatomical position. Most movements have an opposite
